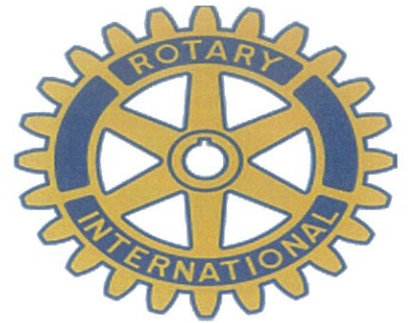


# Rotary Club of PETERHEAD
